Medicare Environmental Management Pvt Ltd of Anil Kumar is hereby granted an authorisation based on the enclosed signed inspection report for generation, collection, reception, storage, transport, reuse, recycling, recovery, pre-processing, co-processing, utilisation, treatment, disposal or any other use of hazardous or other wastes or both on the premises situated at Plot No 82P, 83 to 89 & 90P, RIADA Industrial Area, Lohardaga, Jharkhand

(1) The authorisation shall be valid for a period of 5 year from the date of issue

(2) The authorisation is subject to the following general and specific conditions (Please specify any conditions that need to be imposed over and above general conditions, if any):

**A General conditions of authorisation:**

1. The authorised person shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the rules made there under.
2. The authorisation or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorised by the State Pollution Control Board.
3. The person authorised shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the hazardous and other wastes except what is permitted through this authorisation.
4. Any unauthorised change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorised shall constitute a breach of his authorisation.

5. The person authorised shall implement Emergency Response Procedure (ERP) for which this authorisation is being granted considering all site specific possible scenarios such as spillages, leakages, fire etc. and their possible impacts and also carry out mock drill in this regard at regular interval of time.
6. The person authorised shall comply with the provisions outlined in the Central Pollution Control Board guidelines on “Implementing Liabilities for Environmental Damages due to Handling and Disposal of Hazardous Waste and Penalty”
7. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the State Pollution Control Board to close down the facility.
8. The imported hazardous and other wastes shall be fully insured for transit as well as for any accidental occurrence and its clean-up operation.
9. The record of consumption and fate of the imported hazardous and other wastes shall be maintained.
10. The hazardous and other waste which gets generated during recycling or reuse or recovery or pre-processing or utilisation of imported hazardous or other wastes shall be treated and disposed of as per specific conditions of authorisation.
11. The importer or exporter shall bear the cost of import or export and mitigation of damages if any.
12. An application for the renewal of an authorisation shall be made as laid down under these Rules.
13. Any other conditions for compliance as per the Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change or Central Pollution Control Board from time to time.
14. Annual return shall be filed by June 30th for the period ensuring 31st March of the year.

**B Specific conditions:**

1. That, the occupier shall submitted AAQ, SMR & Effluent analysis report every year to the Board.
1. That, the occupier shall dispose hazardous Waste through Registered recycler.
2. That, the occupier shall submit manifest to the Board in prescribed form-10 regularly.
3. That, the occupier shall transport the Hazardous waste safely and shall ensure that no leakage should occur during transportation.
4. That, the occupier shall maintain record of hazardous waste in form-3.
5. That, the occupier shall maintain good housekeeping by cleaning & wetting of the ground regularly.
6. That, the occupier shall inform to the Board in case any accident occurs inside the premises or out side premises.
7. That, the occupier shall install Hazardous Waste Display Board as per prescribed format at factory main gate.
8. That, the occupier shall comply the Standard Operating Procedure(SOP) issued by Central Pollution Control Board.
9. That, the occupier shall comply all the conditions of authorization.
